In June of 2015, a highly experienced Fire Captain from a Lakes Region Department was leading his crew through a building fire as part of the team's mission to preserve life and property. Conditions inside quickly deteriorated, leaving the Captain separated from his crew mates and unable to orient himself to evacuate the building. He made a split second decision to call a "May-Day". What transpired in the aftermath is a lesson in individual and organizational resiliency, trust, and teamwork. Regardless of the role that you serve in your department, employ strategies for creating a culture that encourages people to seek help without judgement or unproductive criticism. Use moments of vulnerability to increase the capacity and capability to your organization.
